



## **PROGRAM DETAILS**



Single Parent Connection Inc., a nonprofit organization serving Central Indiana families, is offering the Level Up Financial Wellness Program. Level Up is a 12-week financial literacy cohort that walks single parents through lessons and action steps, preparing them to emerge as knowledgeable and confident leaders of their household.



The Level Up program offers small class sizes, one on one mentoring, and real-life financial problem solving, all in a supportive and fun environment. Participants can earn financial incentives upon graduation, as well as after completing quarterly check-in meetings and action steps.



Level Up follows a hybrid model. Classes are held both in-person and online, Saturdays from 11am-2pm. **6 class dates are required for this program:** In Person - June 1st, June 29th, July 27th Online - June 15th, July 13th, August 10th In Person classes are at Merchants Bank/RDOOR 441 W. Michigan Street (across from IUPUI) Indianapolis, IN 46202 Online classes will be held via Zoom.

## **WHY SIGN UP?**

The Level Up program goes beyond a typical 1-day financial literacy workshop. This program takes you on a financial journey, challenging your thinking and current financial strategies, while offering practical and real-life solutions that work!









The Level Up program is open to single parents who are residents of the Indianapolis area, and have children under age 18 residing in their home. The enrollment fee is \$35, which is your investment (your skin in the game), motivating you to achieve your personal and financial goals.

Bonus Option: Add (1) child, age 13-18, for just \$5 more!

## WHAT WILL I RECEIVE?



Participants will earn a \$200 stipend upon successful completion of the Level Up program - more than 5x's your \$35 investment! Graduates can also earn additional stipends by completing quarterly check-in meetings following graduation. Stipends can be used to help with debt repayment, to increase your savings, or to help establish a family emergency fund! Learning materials and lunch will be provided for in person classes. Bus cards and gas cards are available for parents in need of transportation assistance. Stipends are limited to (1) per family.

## WHAT WILL I ACCOMPLISH?



Participants will complete a financial needs analysis, gain a better understanding of how to manage and rebuild credit, create a personal budget, create a simple and living will, create and implement a personal debt repayment plan, learn how to calculate debt-to-income ratios, AND MORE! Your classmates will be single parents, JUST LIKE YOU, making the learning experience, relaxed, positive, relatable, and fun!
